

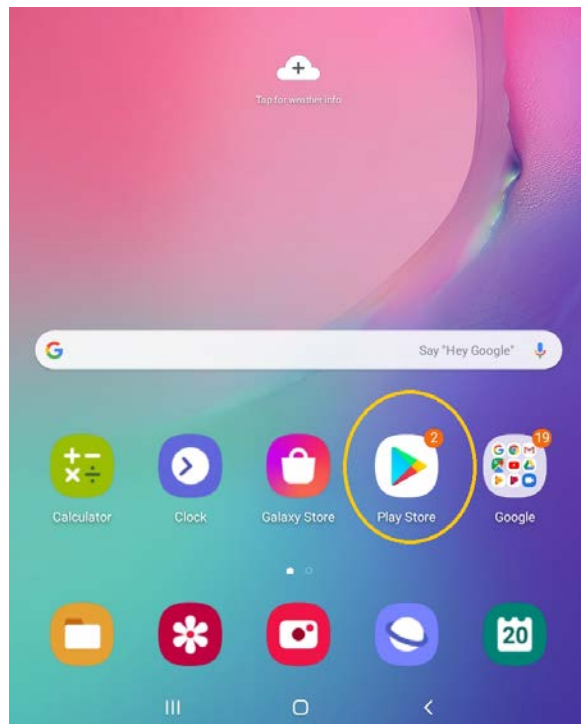
# Using Tablet as a White Board on Zoom

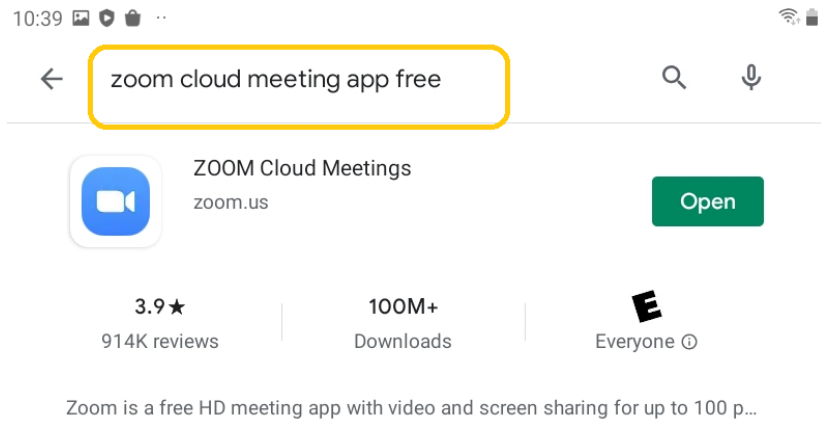
## REQUIREMENTS

- a. PC (Windows) or Mac as a primary computer
- b. Android tablet or iPad or other touch screen device as a secondary device
- c. Internet Connection on both devices
- d. Joining the same Zoom meeting on both devices (Primary computer and tablet) to use tablet as a white board
- e. Stylus (optional)

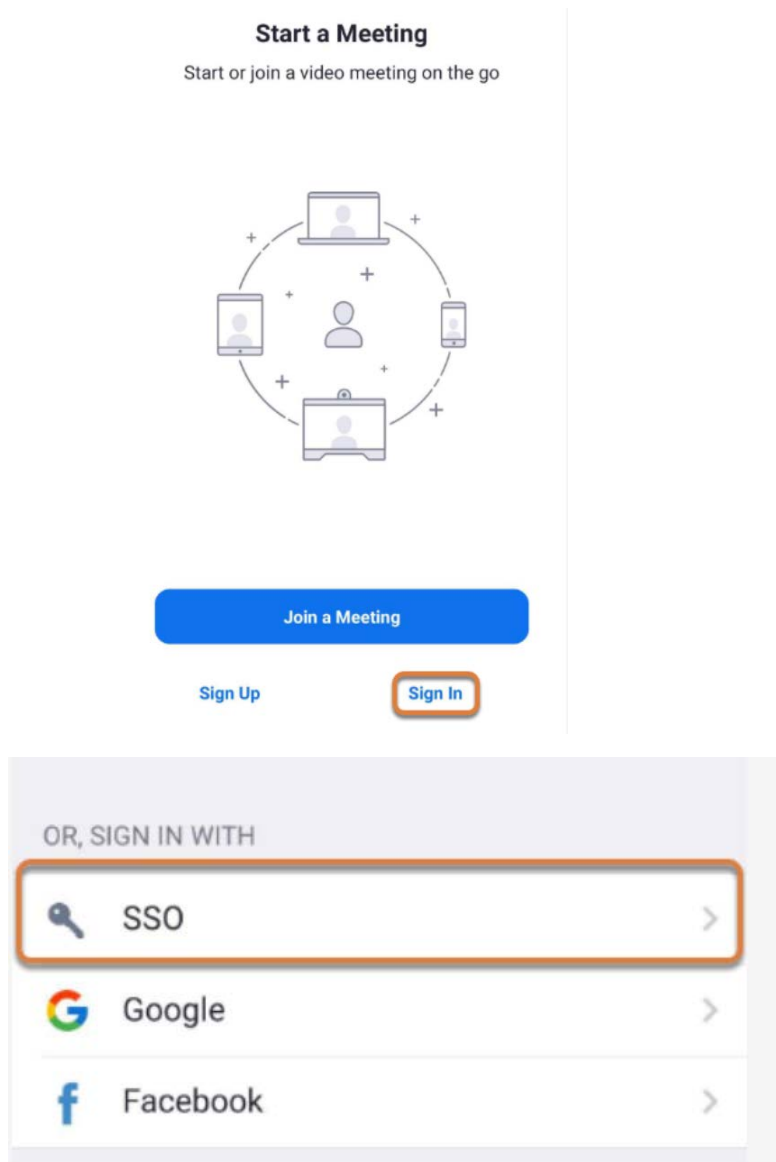
## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Install Zoom on your computer ( [www.zoom.us/download](http://www.zoom.us/download) ). Sign in with SSO (WUSTL key and password).
2. Download Zoom App on your Android tablet by going to the **Play Store**. If you are trying to use an iPad as a second device, download Zoom by going to the App Store.

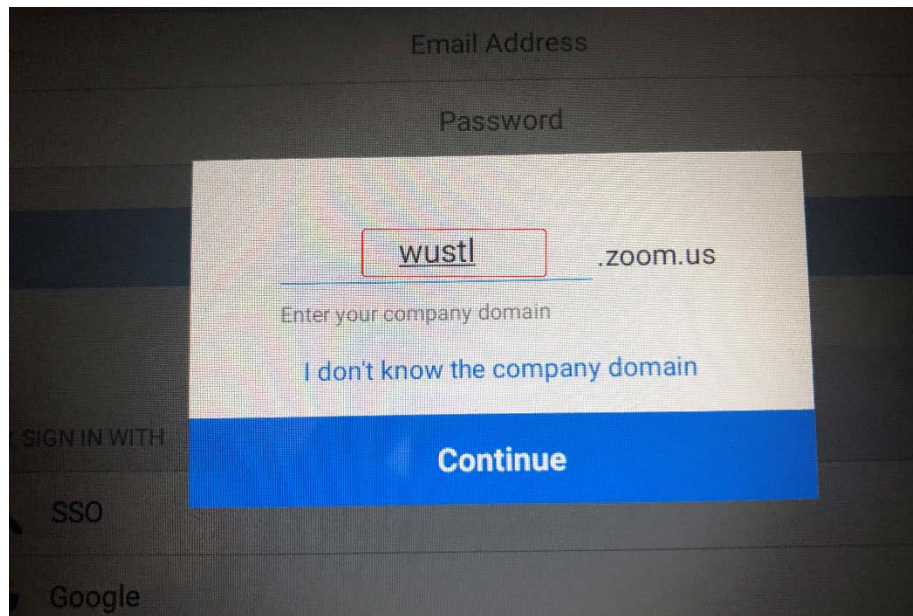




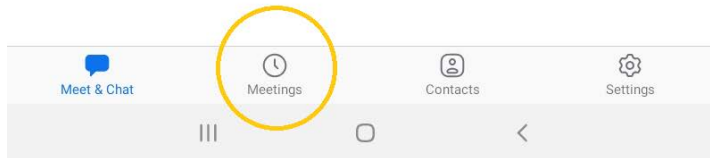
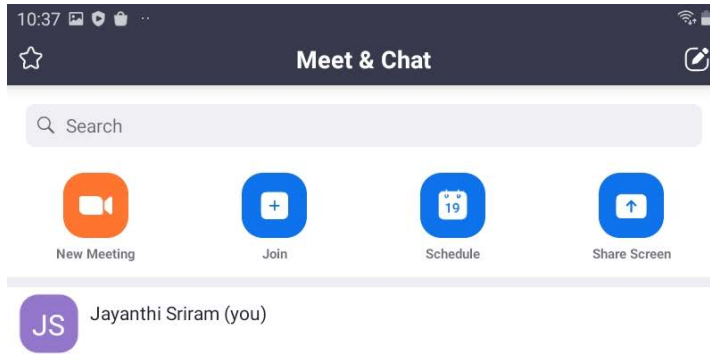
3. Once Zoom is downloaded, Sign in with SSO option



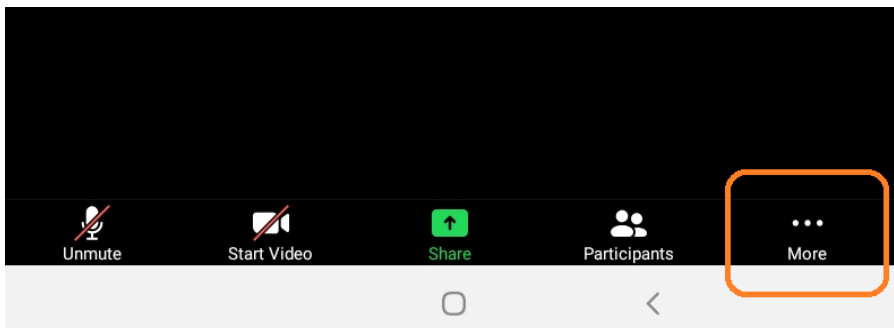
4. Enter the domain name as wustl.zoom.us, click continue and then login with WUSTL key.



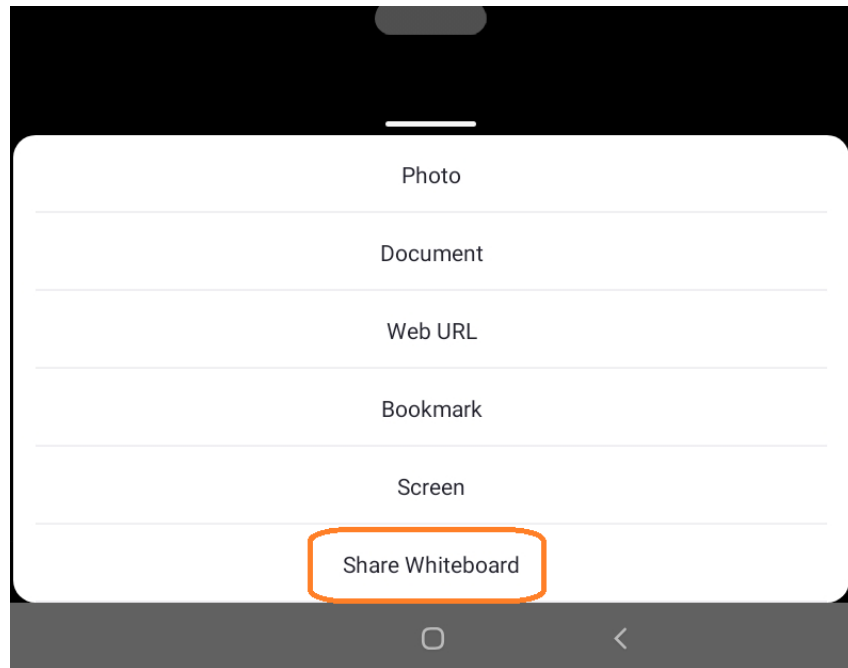
5. Once Zoom account is set up on your tablet (or iPad), go to Zoom on your primary computer and start your meeting.
6. Go to Zoom on tablet, select **Meetings** from the menu options from the bottom of the page. Then find the same meeting you started on your primary computer and **start/join** the same.



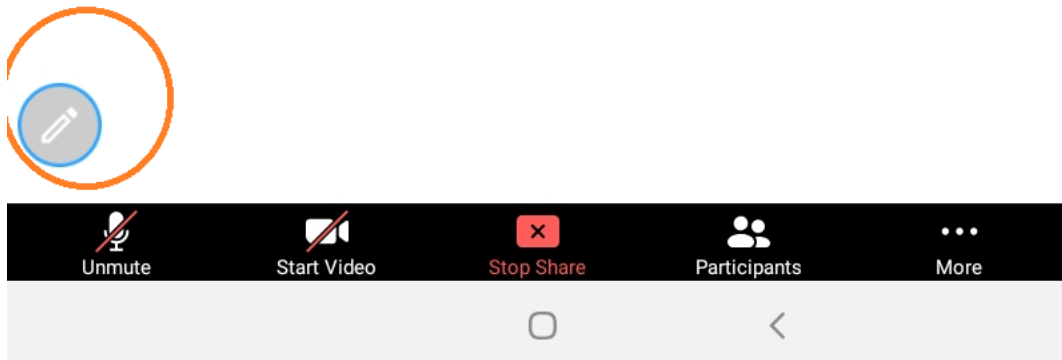
7. As soon as you join the meeting on the tablet, **disconnect audio**. Tap near the bottom of your screen to show menu options to unmute, share, participants etc. Click on **More** and **disconnect audio**. This reduces audio feedback.



8. Click on the green **Share** button from the menu option and select **whiteboard** to share whiteboard



9. Click on the pencil option to start writing on the white board.



10. Use your stylus to write and share your work. Click on the three dots at the bottom of the screen to save or start a new whiteboard or record the work.
